



I-95/SCUDDER FALLS BRIDGE IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

PROJECT NEEDS

- Improve mobility on this segment of I-95 to provide for interstate commerce and to accommodate movement of people and goods between Pennsylvania and New Jersey.
- Provide adequate shoulders to enhance safety and traffic flow. Provide adequate outside shoulders (break down lanes) on the I-95/Scudder Falls Bridge to provide pullover areas for vehicles in the event of a breakdown, crash, emergency, or other incident.
- Provide adequate acceleration and deceleration lanes at adjoining interchanges, and adequate spacing of ramp merges, to improve traffic flow and enhance safety for merging of traffic from adjoining NJ Route 29 and Taylorsville Road.
- Provide adequate roadway capacity to provide acceptable traffic operations during peak travel periods (generally defined as level of service D in urban areas).
- Improve interchange configurations that do not currently meet design criteria for lane and shoulder widths and ramps configurations.
